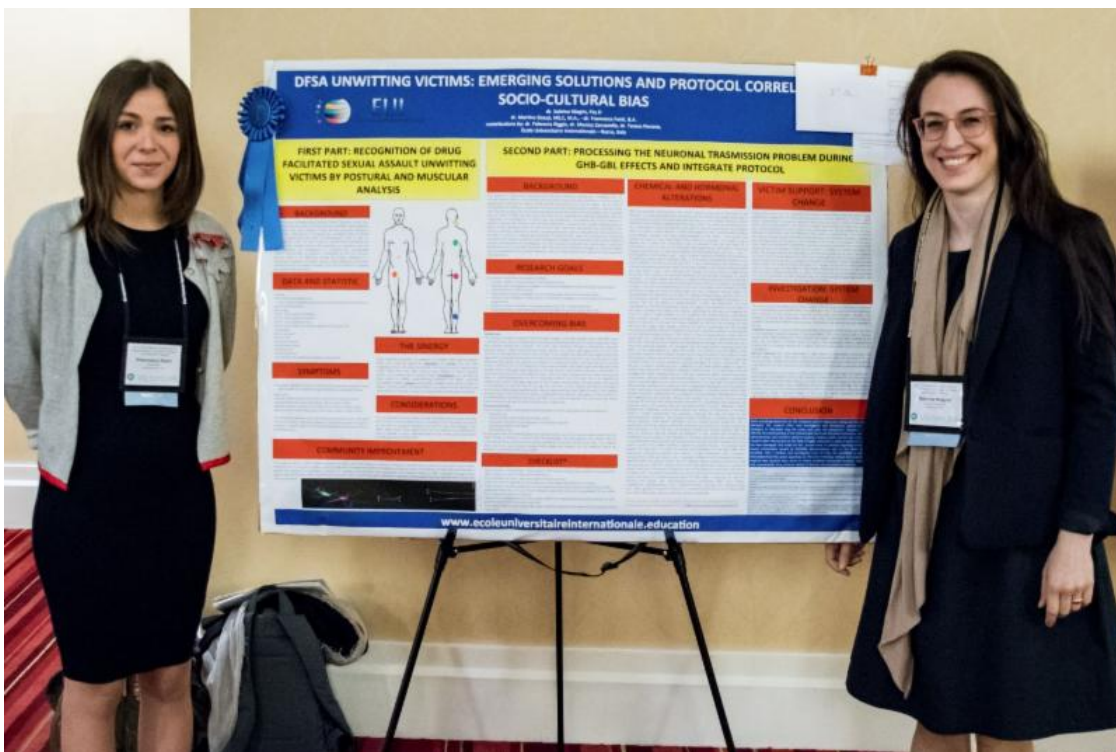


2017 Poster Presentations
